



Habitat for Humanity Mississippi Capital Area enlists community in revitalization of historic Broadmoor neighborhood



Representatives from churches, businesses, schools and government gathered with Habitat for Humanity supporters and staff June 27 to dedicate the first two houses rehabbed as part of the non-profit's new Broadmoor Initiative. The goal is to rehab and build 100 houses in 5 years.

Habitat for Humanity Mississippi Capital Area announced recently that it is launching a five-year initiative to revitalize the historic Broadmoor neighborhood in north Jackson. The announcement was made during the noon dedication, Thursday, June 27, of the first two houses to be rehabbed as a part of this initiative; they are located at 757 and 758 Avalon Road. The goal is to rehab 100 houses over five years, according to Merrill McKewen, Habitat's executive director.

Created in the early 1950's as a neighborhood for GIs returning from World War II, the Broadmoor neighborhood was a place teaming with families and their children. Streets were named after major campaigns and individuals associated with WWII in Western Europe and the Pacific – for ex-

ample, Manila, Normandy, Churchill and Casablanca.

The neighborhood then became a place for first-time homebuyers, and baby boomers continued to live in the area throughout the early 1990s. Then a great deal of it became rental property lacking care. The area also suffered from the 2008 housing market crash with high rates of foreclosure.

"Our goal is to revitalize this neighborhood for the newest generation of first-time homebuyers," McKewen said. "By using the structural integrity of the houses, our goal will be to offer completely remodeled homes for those in need of decent, affordable houses."

"There are many pluses that make the neighborhood attractive today for revitalization," she said. "The character of the neigh-

Walters' proven leadership in the areas of student enrollment and retention, fundraising and policy development made her the ideal candidate for the College.







borhood is the “post-war box” – moderately
sized, well-constructed, structurally sound
homes – along with mature trees and large,
beautiful lots that are ideal for first-time
homebuyers. The neighborhood is also near
many amenities such as major thorough-
fares, shopping centers, schools, churches
and potential jobs. As a bonus, if a house is
beyond repair, we will be able to demo the
house through a Blight Elimination Program
though the City of Jackson, thereby, improv-
ing the neighborhood for everyone.”

Sharing the dream for the revitalization
of Broadmoor is a 20-member committee of
stakeholders representing businesses, gov-
ernment, schools and faith-based institutions
that support Habitat for Humanity Missis-
sippi Capital Area’s (HFHMCA) work in the
Broadmoor area.

“At the Redeemer Church, we believe in
the theology of place,” said Pastor Elbert
McGowan Jr. “We want ‘shalom’ for the
physical and tangible being of this neighbor-
hood as well as the spiritual. Habitat’s com-
mitment to rehab 100 houses in five years is
a huge part in bringing ‘shalom’ for Broad-
moor.”

Cherry Buckner, who has lived in Broad-
moor for 43 years and raised two daughters
there, is excited about the revitalization un-
derway.

“When I moved here, it was the perfect
place for young couples and families just
starting out,” she said. “I have lived here a
long time, I love my house, and I love the
convenient location of the neighborhood. I
am pleased with Habitat’s commitment to
Broadmoor and our getting new homeown-
ers who realize that a home is an invest-
ment. I love that Habitat offers individuals
who buy their homes classes about finance

and budgeting and home maintenance. It’s a
win-win for everyone – the new homeown-
ers, the current homeowners and the neigh-
borhood in general.”

The two houses dedicated today were
sponsored by Selby and Richard McRae
Foundation and the Regions Foundation.
Habitat for Humanity has acquired addi-
tional properties in Broadmoor and already
received commitments for more rehabs in
2019:

- Women Build, a rehab currently in prog-
ress that is sponsored by women donors and
volunteers throughout the tri-county area
- Catholic Build, a rehab sponsored by a
partnership of Catholic churches in the tri-
county area
- Five rehabs funded through a federal
HOME Investment Partnerships Program
grant from the City of Jackson
- Bankers Build, a rehab sponsored by a
partnership of Jackson area banks.

During the dedication, it was announced
that Blue Cross & Blue Shield of Mississippi
will sponsor the first new build of the Broad-
moor Initiative. Construction will take place
this fall.

“We are pleased that all of our corporate,
community and religious sponsors of Habi-
tat homes are coming with us to Broadmoor
to have the largest impact possible, and, of
course, we welcome new sponsors – individ-
uals, businesses, churches and others – who
want to be a part of the exciting revitaliza-
tion of this historic neighborhood,” McK-
ewen said.

Lucy Allen has retired as director of the MDAH Museum Division after forty years of service to the department. She led the division through the restoration and reopening of the Old Capitol Museum, the creation of the Eudora Welty House and Garden, and the development and construction of the Two Mississippi Museums, which have attracted more than 320,000 visitors since opening in December 2017.

“Lucy Allen was an outstanding leader of the Museum Division, and the Two Mississippi Museums stand as her greatest achievement,” said MDAH director Katie Blount. “Cindy Gardner, who has been at Lucy’s side for the past twenty years, will continue Lucy’s commitment to telling Mississippi’s stories through powerful exhibits and public programs.”

Gardner has been selected as the new director of the Museum Division. She served at MDAH as the collections registrar at the Old Capitol Museum, director of collections for the department’s Museum Division, and most recently, as administrator of the Two Mississippi Museums. Gardner earned her bachelor’s degree from Stetson University in Florida.

At the 2018 Southeastern Museum Conference annual meeting, Gardner received the Museum Leadership Award for advancing the museum profession.

agency,” said Gardner. “I am proud to announce that we are merging our staff at the Museum of Mississippi History and Mississippi Civil Rights Museum to strengthen our programming and visitor experience.

“Pamela Junior will serve as the director of the Two Mississippi Museums and Rachel Myers will become the deputy director. Dorian Pridgen will serve as director of visitor experience

and Clay Williams will continue to serve as sites administrator for MDAH sites across the state.”

Junior joined MDAH in 2017 as director of the Mississippi Civil Rights Museum. Previously, she managed the Smith-Robertson Museum and Cultural Center in Jackson for eighteen years. Junior earned her bachelor’s degree in education from Jackson State University. She is the recipient of the

Freedom Rider’s award from the Mississippi Freedom 50th Foundation, the For My People award from the Margaret Walker Center at Jackson State University and the Hometown Hero award from Visit Jackson.

Myers, who has served as the director of the Museum of Mississippi History, will now serve as deputy director of the Two Mississippi Museums. Before joining MDAH in 2017, she was

director of the Museum Department of the Goldring/Woldenberg Institute of Southern Jewish Life and worked as a program assistant at the New England Aquarium in Boston, Massachusetts. She holds a bachelor’s degree in religious studies from Brandeis University and a master’s in museum studies from Johns Hopkins University.

Dorian Pridgen will oversee the operations of the Mississippi Museum Store and manage facility rental and visitor services at MDAH sites. She has worked as the visitor services coordinator at the Two Mississippi Museums since 2017. Pridgen has taught at elementary and middle schools in Mississippi, Texas and New Orleans. She also served as the school programs director at the Mississippi Museum of Art for four years. Pridgen earned bachelor’s and master’s degrees in education from Jackson State University.

American Visions nominees represent the "Best of Show" among Gold Key-winning works from each local


program. Only five works from all categories and grades are selected for the American Visions Medal.

It gives citizens and public officials an opportunity to commend the work of outstanding officers, like Hoskins, whose work is far-reaching and deeply impactful within their communities.

Hoskins is a 25-year law enforcement veteran.


West Jackson Rotary members presented the books to students before the end of the school year in May.

Jordan named MSU's interim VP for research and economic development

Julie Jordan has been named Mississippi State University's interim vice president of research and economic development (ORED).

The current associate vice president for international programs and executive director of the MSU International Institute is a veteran higher education administrator who previously served for seven years as director of MSU's Research and Curriculum Unit. She assumes her new duties July 1, pending formal approval by the Board of Trustees, State Institutions of Higher Learning.

Jordan, an MSU alumnus, succeeds David R. Shaw, who was recently promoted to MSU's provost and executive vice president.

MSU President Mark E. Keenum applauded Jordan's appointment: "I have long admired Dr. Jordan's leadership skills and solid work ethic. I have every confidence she will do an outstanding job as interim vice president for research and economic development."

As Mississippi's leading research university, research is a vital aspect of the university's mission. MSU remains ranked among the nation's top 100 research institutions in the most recent report from the National Science Foundation and is classified as an R1 "Very High Research Activity" university by the Carnegie Foundation.

Jordan began leading the International Institute on an interim basis in October 2017 and was named the permanent director in June 2018. The International Institute reports equally to MSU's Office of the Provost and Executive Vice President, ORED and Division of Agriculture, Forestry and Veterinary Medicine.

At the RCU, the Columbus resident led and managed a staff of 40 professionals, while increasing external funding and ex-

panding the unit's impact. During the past two years, she has worked with university leaders and the Office of Research and Economic Development to expand MSU's partnerships in Morocco and cultivate new partnerships around the world.

With more than 30 years of professional experience as a business owner, entrepreneur, teacher and trainer, Jordan also previously worked for the university as a project manager for the Mississippi State Community Action Team.

"Julie brings a great deal of relevant experience to this important position," Shaw said. "Throughout her MSU career, she has stepped up to serve in important leadership roles. I appreciate her commitment to nurturing and growing our academic partnerships and research collaborations."

The NSF Higher Education Research and Development Survey for Fiscal Year 2017 places the university at 94th overall among public and private institutions in the country, based on nearly \$241 million in total research and development expenditures. It is ranked 58th among non-medical school institutions, and 64th among public institutions.

For the most recent year reported, Mississippi State ranks 64th among all engineering colleges nationally in research and development expenditures, ninth in agricultural sciences research, and 17th in social sciences. The university's programs in computer sciences, geosciences, chemistry and life sciences all are ranked in the top 100.

USM Panhellenic Group helps build new school for children in Africa

University of Southern Mississippi (USM) student Kaitlyn Collins gained a greater appreciation for the luxuries afforded most U.S. residents during a recent trip to Malawi, Africa where she participated in the ground-breaking for a new school.

"Of course, I appreciate running water and electricity, but those are not the luxuries I learned to appreciate most while I was in Malawi," said Collins, a senior elementary education major from Gulfport, Miss. "I learned to appreciate how easy it was for me to receive and afford an education. The ability to receive and afford an education is not something everyone in Malawi gets to experience."

USM's College Panhellenic Council partnered with the University of Indiana on the project, raising funds through the Circle of Sisterhood philanthropy. Megan Wilkinson, assistant director of Fraternity and Sorority Life at USM, explained that the project idea and fundraising effort began in 2016.

"Due to the fundraising commitment timeline, we couldn't do it alone, so we reached out to Circle of Sisterhood to see if there were other schools, like us, who wanted to partner. Indiana University answered the call and we decided it was a good match," she said.

Wilkinson and four USM students joined the Indiana contingent for the official ground-breaking in Kasiya Village May 23. For more than two weeks, the USM group contributed to the initial construction work which included dozens of laborers from the Malawi region.

The school, which will house students in grades 1-8, is expected to be completed in approximately six months. To say the facility is needed would be a drastic understatement.

"For the community where we broke ground, they simply have too many children desiring an education and too few locations to host them," said Wilkinson. "Some are currently meeting in an old church which had no chairs. In the sixth-grade class, they were sharing four books for almost 30 students."

Located in southeast Africa, Malawi is among the world's least developed countries, with about 85 percent of the population living in rural areas. Agriculture remains the primary economic driver for the country's approximately 18 million inhabitants.

Hattiesburg, Miss., native Callie Crider, a junior speech pathology major at USM, noted that what impacted her the most in Malawi was the overwhelming sense of love and community that was present every second during the group's visit.

"For a community that is so isolated and impoverished, it was filled with love and laughter and true happiness that I have missed each day since being back in America," said Crider. "The people there are filled with such curiosity and have big dreams for their lives despite having so many obstacles in their way."

Wilkinson emphasizes that education serves as the cornerstone for economical and societal progress in countries like Malawi where poverty rates are well above average.

"We believe in the power of education to provide opportunities for women worldwide," said Wilkinson. "Breaking the cycle of poverty and illiteracy will allow for the entire community to develop. Physical school buildings provide shelter for students to learn in a consistent environment with desks, chalkboards, and other learning materials."

The eye-opening experience for Collins helped echo Wilkinson's sentiments about the importance of education. Particularly in under-developed regions of the world.

"I believe that education is the number one way to empower people," said Collins. "That could mean educating someone on their choices in presidential candidates, so that they can be an informed voter; or it could mean educating someone on how to read or write, so that they can provide for their families. Education is a right that should be given to every single person on this planet, regardless of age, gender, socioeconomic class, sexual orientation, etc."

Wilkinson fondly recalls the warm welcome she and the USM students received upon arrival in the village. Several children ran more than a mile to greet the van carrying the USM contingent. And while she found the entire experience profoundly rewarding, Wilkinson said an emptiness of sorts still lingers.

"I assumed I would leave Kasiya Village feeling great about the money we raised and the labor we provided to help students. Instead, I left with an unfinished feeling," she said. "The truth

is that these students will still not have an easy access to high school education. It may be generations before they can afford to send more than two or three students to high school."

Thus, much more work beyond the raising of a school structure, needs to be done.

"This is one village whose story is not unique. This is the beginning of very slow progress," said Wilkinson. "Although I am honored to have contributed to this village's educational advancement, I have realized my commitment to education cannot end there. We must continue to support education worldwide to advance and elevate our entire world."





Walking in the footsteps of her father, T.D. Jakes, Cora Jakes Coleman releases her second book urging readers to step out in ferocious faith





she said. "God always has a plan. I couldn't see what God would bring after heartbreak. I just believed He would bring something good."



BOOK REVIEW:

“WIDOWS’ WORDS”

The covers on the other side of the bed are barely rumpled these days.

There’s just one toothbrush in the holder, one plate at the table, one coffee cup in the sink. You didn’t want this, weren’t expecting it, wish it wasn’t happening but here it is, and in “Widows’ Words” by various writers, edited by Nan Bauer-Maglin, you’re absolutely not alone.

Welcome to the club. The rules are simple.

The first one is that no matter

how many well-meaning people came to you in the minutes, days, or weeks after your husband’s funeral, your grief is different than theirs. Everyone heals in their own way, and in their own time but you’ve got sisters who’ve been where you are.

In this book, forty-three of them offer their experiences, organized into five categories to match readers’ stages.

It starts with the moment of diagnosis, the disbelief that it’s happening, the absurdity of seeing x-rays of your husband’s head. It’s holding your wife’s

hand as she dies by her own choice. It’s getting six premature, unwanted copies of a book on grief.

After the funeral, a hundred chores need tending; untangling money matters may be the first, most pressing one but so are the necessities of cleaning out his closet and his office.

You may rely on God, or rant at Him. Milestones will sting: his birthday, your birthday, your anniversary. You may notice that memories of him are slipping away.

And then, well, you come to

realize that living alone isn’t so bad after all. You become a widowed parent with confidence. You somehow learn to do the “scary” things and the hard things and the impossible. You might even feel optimistic, and able to open yourself to new love, even though memories never disappear and you can absolutely count on the past tapping you on the shoulder when you least expect it...

Without a doubt, “Widows’ Words” is a book you never hope you need.

And yet, the chances are you

will, as editor Nan Bauer-Maglin points out: statistically, “women outlive men by about five years” and, because Boomers are aging, the number of widows is rising. In 2016, more nearly 1.5 million people lost a spouse; some two-thirds of them, she says, were women.

For them, this book follows an arc of need starting with what is imminent, a first part that reads like a howl of pain. Indeed, raw widows might want to go cautiously at those few chapters, lest they rip away fresh scabs.

Ultimately, relief sets in: sub-

sequent chapters show healing (or at least growing acceptance), and come from widows of all ages and walks of life including same-sex widows, interracial widows and women with children who may or may not remember their fathers.

From these latter chapters comes gentle, wry humor and strong advice that feels like it’s offered in a warm blanket and a hug. It all makes “Widows’ Words” a great reference and good comfort even though, for the newly bereaved, it can’t begin to cover everything.
